REVELATION: OUR ETERNAL DWELLING **Revelation 22**

August 27, 2023

BIG IDEA: As believers, restoration awaits us.

THE RIVER OF LIFE (vv. 1-5)

Rivers can represent <u>peace</u> and <u>provision</u>. (Isaiah 48:18; Psalm 46:4-5)

The tree of life could represent the <u>restoration</u> of all things. (Genesis 2:9)

Eternity will be a place of work and service. (Revelation 7:15)

In eternity nothing will obscure our fellowship with Him. (1 Corinthians 13:12)

JESUS IS COMING (vv. 6-21)

Revelation was written to a <u>first</u> century audience. (Revelation 1:1, 4)

The main purpose of prophecy is to lead us to <u>trust</u> and <u>obey</u> God. (Revelation 1:3)

We must not worship people or angels but God alone. (Revelation 19:10)

Jesus' coming brings with it judgment. (Isaiah 40:10)

Only the <u>righteous</u> will have access to eternal life. (Psalm 118:20)

God invites us to come and drink freely. (Isaiah 55:1)

Revelation reminds us to be <u>ready</u> and <u>watchful</u>. (1 Peter 4:7)
