LIVING READY IN A DARK WORLD

1 Thessalonians 5:1-11

September 14, 2025

BIG IDEA: Since we belong to the <u>day</u>, we must live <u>ready</u> for Christ's return.

THE DAY OF THE LORD WILL COME SUDDENLY (vv. 1-3)

Christ's return is <u>certain</u>, but the timing is <u>unknown</u>.

The world will be <u>unprepared</u>, trusting in false security.

WE ARE CHILDREN OF THE DAY, NOT THE NIGHT (vv. 4-8)

Our <u>identity</u> shapes our lifestyle—children of the light live differently.

Daylight living means <u>alertness</u>, self-control, and being dressed appropriately.

OUR DESTINY IS SALVATION, NOT WRATH (vv. 9-11)

God has appointed us for salvation through Christ, not destruction.

Christ's death guarantees life with Him—whether in death or at His return.

QUESTION TO PONDER

Would my lifestyle encourage others to be more ready for Jesus' return—or less, and what would be some evidence of my faith?
