FALSE TEACHERS Titus 1:10-16 March 16, 2025

Dangers of False Teachers (vv. 10-12)

False teachings are not just harmless ideas—they can <u>destroy</u> families, churches, and entire communities.

Rebuke and Correct False Teachers (vv. 13-14)

The goal of this rebuke is not to destroy but to correct and restore.

Tradition should <u>support</u> the truth, not <u>replace</u> it.

True & False Believers (vv. 15-16)

A pure heart sees the world through the lens of God's truth.

A true relationship with God will be evidenced by our <u>obedience</u> to His Word and our <u>love</u> for others.

False teachers either teach something <u>untrue</u> about Jesus or they <u>distract</u> people from Jesus.

False teachers thrive when people are biblically illiterate.
