## NEHEMIAH INTRO AND BACKGROUND

January 7, 2024

**BIG IDEA:** The LORD will <u>never</u> leave nor forsake His people.

## THE BABYLONIAN CAPTIVITY (Jeremiah 25, 2 Kings 24, 2 Chronicles 36)

Israel was plagued with *idolatry* and *rebellion* against Yahweh.

God used Babylon as His agent of judgment against Israel.

The captivity lasted for <u>70</u> years as prophesied by Jeremiah.

## THE DESTRUCTION OF THE FIRST TEMPLE (Lamentations 1, 2 Kings 25)

The first temple was built by <u>Solomon</u>.

A godly structure for worship did not create godly people.

The Babylonians <u>burned</u> and <u>ransacked</u> the temple.

The first temple was destroyed in 586 B.C..

## ZERUBBABEL, EZRA AND NEHEMIAH

Zerubbabel was concerned about building the temple.

Ezra was concerned about building spiritual lives.

Nehemiah was concerned about the rebuilding of Jerusalem's walls.
