MOCKERY AND CRUCIFIXION

This cruel mockery of His kingship demonstrates the depths of human <u>depravity</u> and the rejection of God's <u>Anointed</u> One.

It is terrible to be forced to endure such <u>torture</u>, but to freely choose it out of love is <u>remarkable</u>.

OUR RESPONSE

Gratitude: The enormity of Christ's sacrifice should evoke <u>profound</u> gratitude in our hearts.

Repentance: Recognizing the cost of our redemption should lead us to <u>genuine</u> repentance.

Living for Christ: Our lives should <u>reflect</u> the high cost of our redemption.

Sharing the Gospel: The message of Christ's redemptive work is too <u>precious</u> to keep to ourselves.
