ADVENT: JOY Luke 2:10-11 December 10, 2023

**BIG IDEA:** The <u>Joy</u> of believers is <u>available</u> no matter the circumstances.

## **JOY COMES FROM CHRIST**

We <u>rejoice</u> in our <u>sufferings</u>, knowing that suffering produces endurance. (Romans 5:1-3)

Out of the <u>anguish</u> of His soul he shall see and be <u>satisfied</u>. (Isaiah 53:11)

Jesus desires that <u>His</u> joy may be in us, and that our joy may be <u>full</u>. (John 15:11)

Jesus tells us in John 15 that abiding in Him is the key to life.

Jesus prayed not only for His disciples to receive His joy but also for whoever will <u>believe</u> in Him through <u>their</u> message. (John 17:20)

#### **JESUS MODELS ENDURING JOY**

Jesus is the <u>founder</u> and <u>perfecter</u> of our faith, who for the <u>Joy</u> set before him endured the cross. (Hebrews 12:2)

Count it all <u>Jov</u> when you meet <u>trials</u>. (James 1:2-3)

### **FUTURE AND PRESENT JOY**

Our present and future joy both come from keeping our eyes on <u>Jesus</u>.

Even though we do not <u>see Him</u> now, we still believe in Him and rejoice with <u>Joy</u> that is inexpressible and filled with glory. (1 Peter 1:3-9)
