

DEAD TO SIN, ALIVE IN CHRIST

Romans 6:1-14

BIG IDEA: Our union with Christ allows us to walk in the newness of life.

DEAD TO SIN AND ALIVE IN CHRIST (Romans 6:1-10)

We have died to sin and can no longer live in it. (vv. 1-2)

We were baptized into the death of Christ and have been raised to walk in new life. (vv. 3-5)

Our old self was crucified with Christ so that the body of sin need not dominate us any longer. (vv. 6-7)

Christ, being unable to die again, has mastery over death and now lives permanently to God. (vv. 8-10)

PRESENT YOURSELF TO GOD (Romans 6:11-14)

We should not let sin reign in our mortal bodies so that we obey its desires. (vv. 11-12)

We should present ourselves not as instruments of unrighteousness, but to God as instruments of righteousness. (v. 13)

Sin will have no mastery over us because we are not under law, but under grace. (v.14)
