NEHEMIAH: A LEGACY OF LEADERSHIP **Nehemiah 2:11-20**

PRINCIPLE #3 – A leader assesses the situation and forms a strategy.

CLARITY (vv. 11-16)

Leaders must take time to assess. (Luke 14:28-33)

Close <u>inspection</u> helps a leader develop a plan. (*Proverbs 21:5*)

Leaders must discern what information to share. (Proverbs 15:23)

COMMUNICATION (vv. 17-18)

Leaders must define <u>reality</u> for people. (Matthew 24:6-13)

Leaders must cast a God-centered vision. (Proverbs 29:18)

Leaders must get <u>buy-in</u> from the people. (Matthew 20:26; 2 Timothy 2:15)

CONTENDING (vv. 19-20)

God's plan may face opposition. (1 Peter 4:12-13)

Leaders must have resolve when faced with adversity. (Joshua 24:14-15)

CHRIST CONNECTION

Jesus weeps over Jerusalem. (Luke 19:41-44)

Jesus' ascends to heaven. (Acts 1:8)
