PEOPLE OF THE PROMISE: JOSEPH THE PEACE OF OBEDIENCE

Matthew 1:18-25

December 7, 2025

BIG IDEA: Peace comes when we choose obedience to God over anxiety and our own plans.

A PAINFUL DISCOVERY — PEACE SHAKEN (vv. 18–19)

Godly <u>character</u> is revealed not in our best moments, but when our world is shaken.

A DIVINE INTERRUPTION — PEACE OFFERED (vv. 20–21)

God often brings <u>clarity</u> after our obedience begins, not before.

A PROPHETIC ASSURANCE — PEACE <u>CONFIRMED</u> (vv. 22–23)

God's Word anchors us when life feels unstable.

A COSTLY OBEDIENCE — PEACE EMBRACED (vv. 24-25)

Obedience may cost more up front, but compromise costs way more in the end.
