A LEGACY OF LEADERSHIP

PRINCIPLE #9 – A leader puts the right <u>people</u> in the right <u>place</u>.

IDENTITY (vv. 5-60)

Accurate accounting is necessary. (Proverbs 27:23-24)

Different groups of people need to be <u>organized</u> for different jobs. (Exodus 18:19-23)

PURITY (vv. 61-65)

<u>Vetting</u> people is important. (*Titus 1:5-9*)

Exclusion can often bring clarity of vision. (Luke 12:51-53)

GIVING (vv. 66-73)

There are many different resources available. (Romans 12:6-8)

Not everyone will <u>contribute</u>. (1 Timothy 4:14)
