NEHEMIAH:Nehemiah 8March 17, 2024A LEGACY OF LEADERSHIP

LEADERSHIP PRINCIPLE #10: A leader teaches people the truth, yet with <u>grace</u>.

GRACE:

- **G** <u>Gratefulness</u> knowing wholeheartedly that God has <u>shown us</u> grace upon grace. (*John 1:16*)
- **R** <u>Respect</u> the dignity of others and that God is working on <u>them too</u>. (1 Corinthians 15:10)
- A Act Humbly (1 Peter 5:5-6)
- **C** <u>Compassion</u>: the <u>heartfelt</u> concern for others. (Colossians 3:12)
- **E** <u>Examine</u> the Scriptures, letting the Word of God <u>impact</u> every part of our life. (*Hebrews 4:12*)

THOUGHTS TO PONDER

Ezra had a personal commitment to be a man of God's Word (*Read Ezra 7:10*); now we see him calling the entire nation to hear and heed God's Word. — How can you improve your knowledge of God's Word?

Paul wrote to the young pastor, Timothy, "Give attention to the public reading of Scripture" (1 Timothy 4:13).

-- How can you prepare yourself for Sunday mornings better to receive God's Word?
