NEHEMIAH: Nehemiah 1 January 14, 2024 A LEGACY OF LEADERSHIP

PRINCIPLE #1 - A leader feels deeply for people and asks God to move.

REPORT FROM JERUSALEM (vv. 1-3)

Take time to <u>understand</u> others' troubles. (Galatians 6:2-4)

Walls represented <u>security</u> and God's <u>provision</u>. (Nehemiah 6:16)

Brokenness should stir a response in us. (Psalm 34:18)

RESPONSE FROM NEHEMIAH (vv. 4-11)

<u>Prayer</u> should be our first response. (*Philippians 4:6*)

<u>Fasting</u> should make us hungry for the Lord. (Joel 2:12)

Humility and confession are apt responses to fellowshiping with God. (Psalm 25:8-10)

We should be **bold** in our prayers. (Hebrews 4:16)

CHRIST CONNECTION

Jesus feeds the multitudes. (Matthew 15:29-32)

The workers are few. (Matthew 9:35-38)
